Request Maximums:

18 units for the 74-unit Masters of Divinity degree program

15 units for the 60-unit MA(TS)

12 units for the 48-unit MAPS degree

A **maximum** of two APS courses may be substituted in each academic discipline: Biblical Studies, Theology and Ethics, or Ministry. Language courses are counted separately from the two Biblical Studies courses maximum.

Grades and Submission - All undergraduate courses considered for graduate credit must be **grade of "B" or better with a demonstrated competence in the subject matter by means of a term paper or research project** completed for the course and approved by the undergraduate APU faculty, and submitted to the seminary. Once the student has provided proper documentation that is approved by APS faculty, the student will be credited for the course(s).

Cost - The cost for the approved Advanced Standing courses is \$50 per unit.

Units - Units will be posted according to the number of units received in the undergraduate course (2-3), up to the maximum units allowed for the APS graduate course (4).
